BTEC International Level 3 Sport

The BTEC International Level 3 qualification in Sport is perfect for students who want to gain an internationally recognised qualification and aspire to careers in the global sports industry. The Sport pathway is designed to provide an overview of the sector, giving learners the opportunity to gain a broad understanding of the sport industry. Learners will study a range of mandatory units such as Health, Well being and Sport as well as varied and interesting optional units such as Nutrition for Sports Performance. This pathway is suitable for learners who either want to progress directly into industry or onto further or higher education.

100% internally assessed - no exams

The subsidiary diploma includes one mandatory unit and five optional units which can be tailored to the interests of the cohort.

There is no need for learners to perform in sport at a high level, although we would encourage all learners to participate in and have a passion for sport.

IGCSE PE is not a prerequisite, however it is an advantage.

The units are assessed by assignments, using a variety of assessment methods such as case studies, presentations, leaflets and more. Tuition is also varied with learners adopting research based tasks, practical performances, group presentations and teacher led instruction.

Following completion of this course students regularly go on to study further in areas such as Sports Journalism, Coaching, PE Teaching, Physiotherapy, Sports Massage and much more.





BTEC International Level 3 Business

Subsidiary Diploma - equivalent to 1 International A Level

The purpose of the course is to provide students with an in-depth understanding of the wider elements of business that will provide the vital skills, knowledge and applied experience to be successful in future business pathways.

Students learn to research, give presentations, work on projects, work in teams, develop their communication skills and study a wide range of business topics. The breadth of skills and knowledge gives students the opportunity to thrive in many different business sectors.

100% internally assessed - no exams

The Subsidiary Diploma includes two mandatory units and two optional units. These are assessed by completing individual reports, presenting and delivering a project.

Unit 1 - Exploring Business

Students study the purposes, features, structures and operating environments of business organisations, and examine the link between innovation and business survival. This is assessed through an individual report

Unit 2 - Research and Plan a Marketing Campaign

Learners develop an understanding of how marketing research is conducted in order to plan a marketing campaign. This is assessed through an externally set assignment.

Unit 3 - Business Finance

Learners develop the skills and knowledge required to analyse and interpret financial data, enabling them to assess the financial health of a business and suggest how its performance can be improved. This is assessed through an individual report and presenting on behalf of a small business.

Unit 4 - Managing an event

Learners will work as part of a small group to plan, coordinate and manage a business or social enterprise event and evaluate the skills gained. This is assessed through an individual report and taking part in staging an event.
